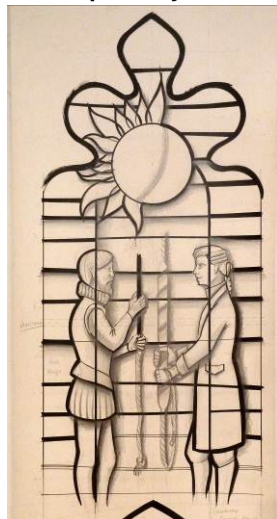

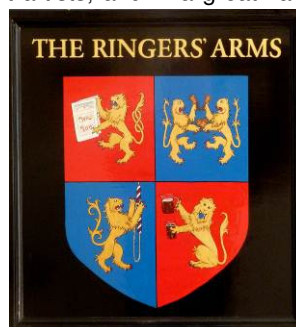

'Art Inspired by Bells'.

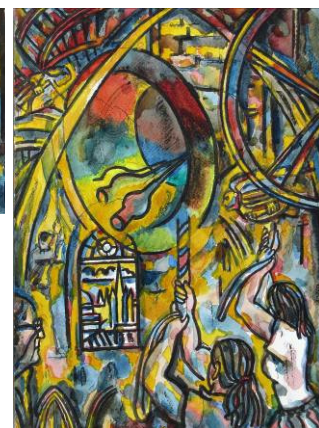


Part of the Ringing World Centenary Day in London on 26th March was an exhibition of 'Art Inspired by Bells' - art by many different artists, and in a great variety of styles and media.

Some items from this exhibition were reproduced in the Ringing World issue which appeared the week before the Centenary Day - here are a few more. **Weimin He** is a Chinese artist based in Oxford. **John Pusey** invited him to watch ringing at Merton and at St Giles. Two pictures of his were in the exhibition. One appeared on the front of the Ringing World. Here is the other - including a profile of John! One painting was in the form of a pub sign - but look closely to see the details which refer to ringing. 'Alpha and Omega' was an embroidered fire screen showing a striking circular design based on the arrangement of the 12 bells at Liverpool Cathedral. Note the sequence of circles representing the bells, arranged in order of size. Another is based on the plain course of Stedman Triples, showing the positions of each bell in a different colour. Opinions vary about which way up to hang it. The last is one of a set of plaques made some years ago by Stella Boswell, who is now a member of the congregation



at St Giles, but based on the tower at Somerby, Leicestershire where she used to live. Like **Weimin He**, she has combined views from different points so as to be able to show both bells and ringers in a single design.
