## Results of the O.D.G. 6 bell Branch Striking Competition at Horspath on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> May.

The results were as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> - Marston-Headington 85%, 2<sup>nd</sup> - St. Giles 80%, 3<sup>rd</sup> - St. Aldates 74%, and 4<sup>th</sup> - Iffley 49%.
