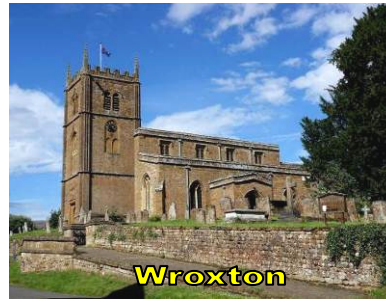

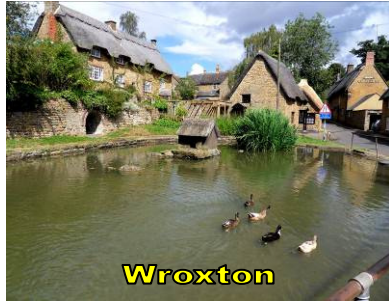

**Swalcliffe**, it was off to **Wroxton**, which is a remarkable village at the very north tip of the county, and one of the small number of villages that appears to have barely altered since time immemorial. There is a wealth of elegant thatched housing, a lovely village pond of such clarity the fish are easily visible and a thatched hut at its centre to protect the ducks from foxes. As you will see from the photo the church looks even more photogenic in the sunny conditions. The bells of 1676, rung from the ground floor, were rehung in a new cast-iron frame in 1998, with the original clappers hanging on the wall.
