

## Bob Benstead's funeral held on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> November at the Oxford Crematorium

Katie Lane, Sheila Browne, and I attended Bob Benstead's funeral at the Crematorium on 13<sup>th</sup> November, so we can say that the Branch was represented. The service was taken by Rev. Andrew Bunch of St Giles. The note in the last issue of Hughs News described Bob as a ringer at St Giles, and he rang 70 quarter-peals at St Giles between 1980 and 2004. However, he was in fact a member of the band at St Aldates for rather longer, having been taught to ring there before the war, and after the wartime ban ended in 1943, he continued ringing at St Aldates until he transferred to St Giles in the early 1980's. The only full peal he rang, according to Pealbase, was of Grandsire Doubles at St Aldates on 19<sup>th</sup> September 1962.


